The candidate will be expected to staff and assist in the clinical evaluation of patients with neurovascular disorders or tumors of the head and neck and to perform endovascular therapy on such patients. Participation in interpretation of diagnostic and therapeutic studies will be required, as well as the performance and staffing of diagnostic angiography. The candidate will be required to participate in the education of residents and medical students. Eligibility for Texas medical licensure and its acquisition prior to the start of employment is required.
