The Department of Internal Medicine, Touchstone Diabetes Center, is seeking an Investigator at the Assistant Professor level. The position requires an MD/PhD or PhD in a basic science discipline and two to five years of postdoctoral experience in the metabolism field. The applicant will develop independent and externally funded as well as collaborative research programs focusing altered metabolic function of adipose tissue with cancer and diabetes risk. The applicant will primarily focus on diabetes research, but will however interface with the Cancer and Nutrition Centers at UTSW. As such, preference will be given to applicants performing “cutting edge” research on diabetes, obesity, neuroendocrinology and sexual dimorphic phenotypes in adipose tissue. Additional duties will include the teaching and training of graduate students, house staff and fellows.
