Disease/Condition Under Study	Kidney Stones/Osteoporosis
Brief Description of Study	A 1 month crossover study with potassium citrate and citric acid. The study will require 4 outpatient visits.
Participant Eligibility	Age: >21 years old
	Use of Topamax for at least 3 months
	Excluded: Those with active cardiac or liver disease, chronic diarrhea, recurrent urinary tract infections
